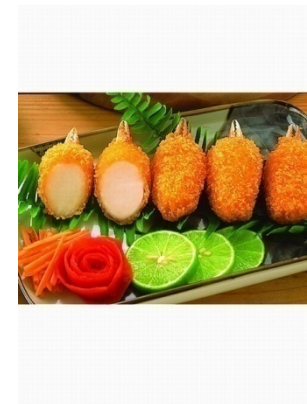

1. Data collection on status of surimi industry and marketing Thailand, Indonesia, Myanmar and Vietnam (consultation visit and questionnaires);
2. Preliminary analysis on the status of surimi industry in relation to fisheries resources; and
3. To evaluate the constraints faced by surimi plants



Introduction – 4

Main Activities in 2007

1. Continue to investigate on the status of surimi industry in Malaysia, Vietnam;
2. Continue to investigate the potential fisheries resources as raw materials species existing in the region, such as trawlable and un-trawlable grounds and continental shelf slopes; and
3. Expert Meeting for progress of the study and finalize the report on status and trend of su
